\$3 000 from various cards: Thrifty's cards, Pre paid cards, Fairways. Prepaid cards are submitted to student accounts.

No final amount is confirmed. It was easy work. In terms of work load it was very nice. It did not help with the student accounts though as the money went to the parent. The PR may not be needed. Our carol band could play in the court.
