Concert Choir Uniforms

-To look professional as well as sound professional, the Reynolds Concert Choir will have a unified look on stage. Singers are required to wear the following for any performance unless otherwise discussed:

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- Black shirt/top. Collared shirts or long sleeves are preferred.

No writing of any kind on the shirt. Please no t-shirts or tank tops.

- Black dress pants/skirt. Jeans or yoga pants are not to be worn for concerts/

performances. Please make sure any skirts are at knee length or lower.

- Black dress shoes or flats. These shoes should not be beat-up old sneakers or flip flops.

- Black socks or skin coloured tights.

-This year choir students will be required to purchase either a blue scarf or blue tie* as part of the choir uniform.

***Please note that if you choose a blue tie and are in band it is the same tie**

-Choir Folders will also need to be purchased for choir, which is all listed on the uniform checklist
