Uniforms:

Evaluation:

Evaluation will be based upon home practice, class participation, and performance.

- performance, by memory, of required scale exercises (looked at in daily warm ups)
- Daily oral work (checking rhythms, terms, key signatures, etc.)
- Regular at home practice
- Participation in class and group performance activities (Music Concerts), most of which occur outside of regular class time. **Participation in Concerts is mandatory for all members**, unless arrangements have been made with the director AHEAD OF TIME. EVERYONE IS IMPORTANT!
- Short playing tests per term, which can be done in class or submitted by video
